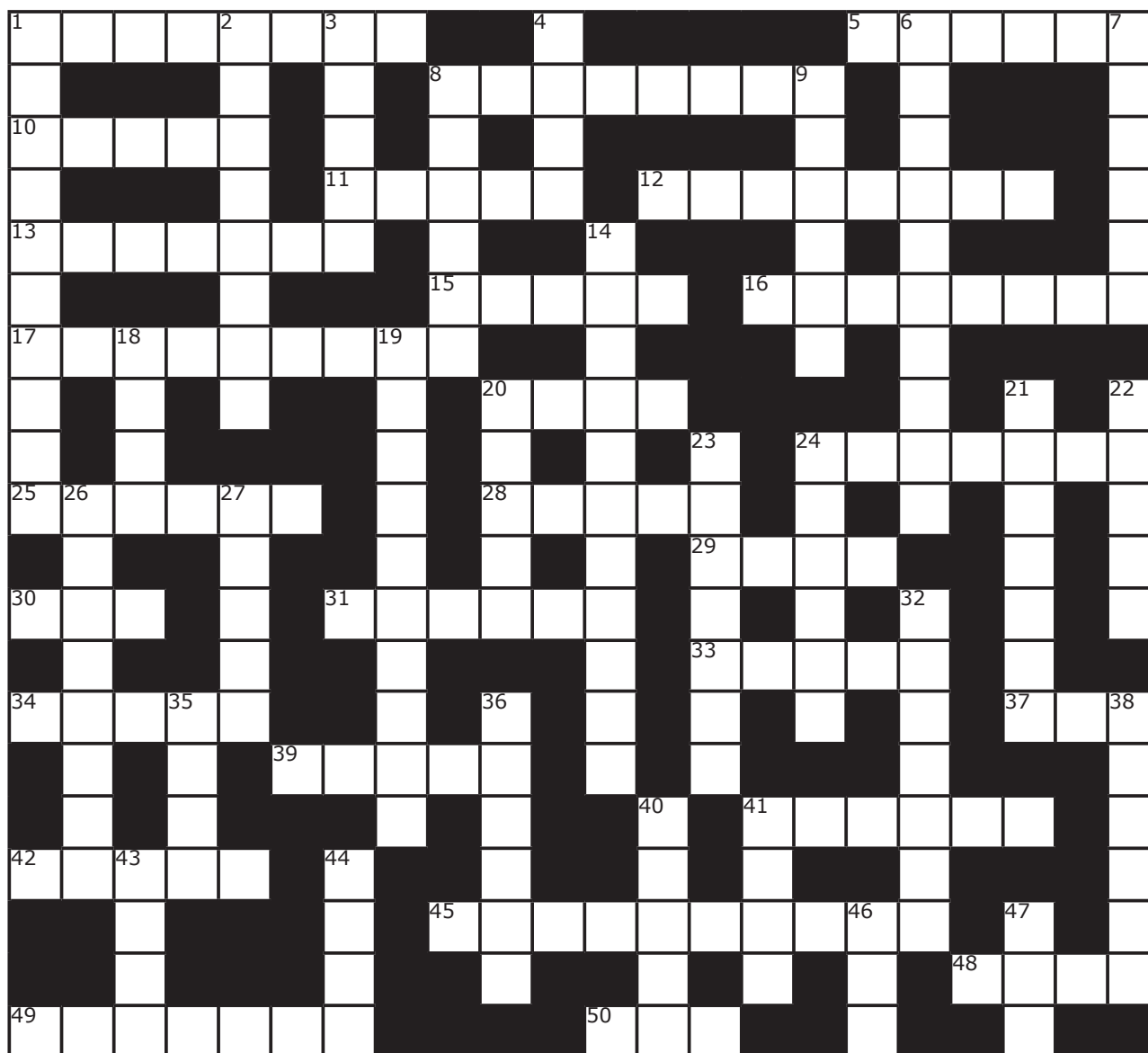


# CEASEFIRE
