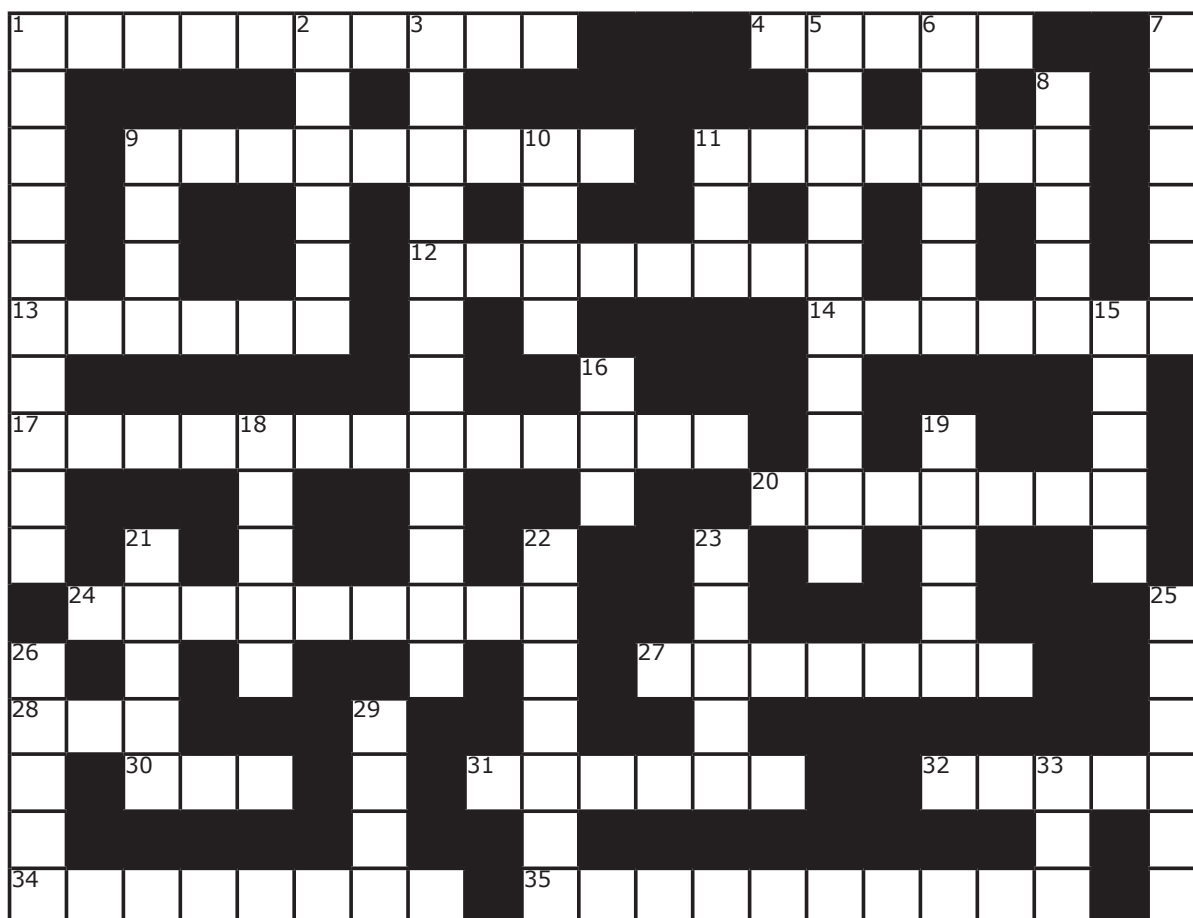


## CONFLICT RESOLUTION
